RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) Darul Quran Hours are 05:00pm – 06:30pm, unless otherwise notified every Mon to Thu.
- 2) Grace time is allowed up to 5 minutes for being late on an occasional basis. If you know that the child will be more than 5 minutes late, a phone call to the class teacher no later than 5:05pm is required to inform that the child will be late. Same rule applies if your child will be absent for the day.
- 3) Islamic dress code is required of all the students in the Darul Quran.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

The students are expected to conduct themselves in a proper, responsible and Islamic manner, respecting their teachers and other adults, their fellow students and all property. A student whose action(s) infringes upon the right(s) of others will be held responsible for the action(s), and disciplinary measures will be taken by the management.
