Whoever suppresses his rage, even though he could fulfil his anger if he wished, then Allah will secure his heart on the Day of Resurrection. - Actual prayer times are based on data collected via sighting.
- It accommodates for Hijri & Greg calendar and day's names are in Arabic & English.

- Jamā'ah times changes only on Jumu'ah (Fri) avoiding unexpected sudden changes.
- Jamā'ah times stays at fixed time for a minimum period of 2 weeks making it convenient for people to work around it.
- Fajr Jamā'ah time takes into consideration the difference amongst scholars regarding the best time to pray Fajr.
- Fixed time for Jumu'ah Khutbah (12.50 pm) throughout the year so working brothers do not have to change their lunch hours every season.
